Eligibility SDS #3

The Short Track Single Distance Series' primary goal is targeted for skaters at the level of Stage 2, 3 and 4 of the [Short track Elite Pathway](#). This ranges in ability in MEN from 41.5 to 46.9 in the 500m and in WOMEN from 46.0 to 50.9 in the 500m.

The SDS series has a secondary goal of providing racing opportunities for developing junior and train to train skaters transitioning to the 111 Oval track, as well as juniors who are striving to achieve Stage 2 standards.

Based on these secondary goals the following minimum time standards* are in effect, this will help create good racing opportunities for everybody:

WOMEN 45.5 400m on the 100m track, or 54.9 500m on the 111m track

MEN 43.0 400m on the 100m track, or 51.9 500m on the 111m track

*** Submitted times must be from an official competition and have to be skated in the previous (Aug 2015) or current season (2016-2017), times skated in practice will not be accepted.**

General Regulations

The 2016 Olympic Oval Short Track Single Distance Series #3 will be held in accordance with the 2016 International Skating Union Regulations and is open to all skaters who belong to an ISU member country.

The Track

The Olympic Oval North Rink is an International size rink measuring at 30m by 60m. The Centurian ST-2000 safety mat system surrounds the north rink to reduce the chance and severity of injury.

Format

The SDS #3 is a single distance competition, skaters will race each distance twice, races will be Semi Finals and Finals. Skaters will be seeded from their submitted times, skaters of similar speed will be seeded together.

Sanction

This competition is sanctioned by Speed Skating Canada and the Alberta Speed Skating Association.

In accordance with ISU Rule 119; the International Skating Union, Speed Skating Canada, Alberta Speed Skating Association, the Olympic Oval, and the University of Calgary assume no responsibility for, or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with the 2016 Olympic Oval Short Track Single Distance Series #2.
